APPLICATION & REGISTRATION

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicant should be a MBBS student (III semester to internship)
- Application should be accompanied by
(Track A) Abstract of small oncology related project work or
(Track B) An innovative oncology related research idea/ hypothesis & how the applicant proposes to approach it.
- Only 25 applicants would be selected by a jury of AIIMS Bhopal faculty on the basis of their project abstracts (Track A) / Innovative idea, hypothesis (Track B).
- For (Track A) Selected students would have to bring their institutional ethics committee cleared project reports in form of a power point presentation and present it at the International School of Oncology – 2019, AIIMS Bhopal. The presentation should be under the headings of – Introduction, Material and Method, Result/Observation, Conclusion. If the projects are not complete at the time of submission of application then the student can submit the abstract with application but will have to complete the projects at their institutions before participating in the ISO 2019.
- For (Track B) Selected students would have to bring their innovative research ideas / hypothesis in form of a power point presentation and present it at the International School of Oncology – 2019, AIIMS Bhopal. The presentation should be under the headings of – Introduction, (proposed) Material and Method and focus on why the proposed research question has been taken up and its defense through literature.
- A maximum of only 10 power point slides are allowed and maximum time allotted will be 5 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for interaction.
- Prizes would be awarded for two best presentations.
Certificates of attendance to all participants will only be provided after participating in the entire course.

SCHEDULE

- The course will be of five days duration in English language.
- In each session one cancer will be covered in an interactive & integrated fashion. The focus would be student centric and practical oriented.
