1. Contractors who fulfill the following requirements shall be eligible to apply. Joint ventures are not accepted.
 - a. Should have satisfactorily completed the works as mentioned below during the last 7 (Seven) years ending **previous day of last date of submission of bids**.
 - i. One similar work each costing not less than ₹ **72.40 Lakhs**.
 - ii. Two similar works each costing not less than ₹ **54.30 Lakhs**
 - iii. Three similar works costing not less than ₹ **36.20 Lakhs**.
 - iv. Similar work means **“Providing & Fixing of Auditorium/ Multiplex chairs”**. The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to last date of submission of bids.
 - b. Should have had average annual **financial turnover** of ₹ **50.00 Lakh** during the immediate last three consecutive financial years. (Scanned copy of Certificate from CA to be uploaded).
 - c. Should not have **incurred any loss** in more than two years during the last five years ending **31st March 2019**.

2. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-7 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
3. Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form of bid document.
4. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website www.tenderwizard.com/AIIMSBHOPAL or www.aiimsbhopal.edu.in.
5. But the bid can only be submitted after **deposition of original EMD in the office of Executive Engineer (E), ABEU AIIMS BHOPAL inviting bids within the period of bid submission** and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipts and Bank Guarantee of any scheduled Bank towards EMD in favour of **Director AIIMS BHOPAL** and other documents as specified.
6. Those contractors not registered on the website mentioned above, are required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on online bidding process as per details available on the website.
7. The intending bidder must have valid *class-I/Class-II/Class-III digital signature* to submit the bid.
8. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.
9. Contractor can upload documents in the form of **JPG** format and **PDF** format.
10. **Certificate of Financial Turn over:** At the time of submission of bid contractor may upload Affidavit/ Certificate from **C.A.** mentioning Financial Turnover of last 3 years or for the period as specified in the bid document and further details if required may be asked from the contractor after opening of technical bids. There is no need to upload entire voluminous balance sheet.
11. Contractor must ensure to quote percentage rate on total cost of work. The column meant for quoting percentage rate in figures appears in Grey colour. In addition to this, while selecting Above / Below or AT PAR if any percentage cell is left blank the same shall be treated as **"0" (ZERO) Percent**. Therefore, if any percentage cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as **"0" (ZERO)**. **However, if a tenderer does not quote any percentage above / below on the total amount of the tender or any section / subhead in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.**
12. The PQ bid will be opened first on due date and time as mentioned above. **The time & date of opening of financial bid of contractors qualifying the eligibility bid will be communicated to them a later date.**
13. **Pre Bid conference** shall be held in the chamber of **Executive Engineer (E), AIIMS, Bhopal** at **11:00 AM** on **21/08/2019** to clear the doubt of intending bidders, if any.
14. When bids are invited in Two stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.

15. The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the laid down criterion.

1. Executive Engineer (E), ABEU, Block No. 10, Hospital Building, AIIMS, Saket Nagar, Bhopal (Phone 0755-2831045, 2900697 email : ee.electrical@aiimsbhopal.edu.in,) on behalf of Director AIIMS, Bhopal invites percentage rate bids from approved & eligible bidders registered with CPWD in appropriate class & category/ Manufacturer/ Specialized Firms who fulfills the PQ criteria in Two Bid System for the work of **“Providing and Fixing of Auditorium Chairs in Main Hall of Auditorium at AIIMS Bhopal.”**

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids.

The work is estimated to **Cost of ₹ 90,50,308/-** This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.

- 1.1 The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids.
- 1.2 Intending bidder is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below:-

2. Criteria of eligibility for submission of bid documents

2.1. Criteria of eligibility for non-CPWD contractors :

- 2.1.1. One similar work each costing not less than ₹ **72.40 Lakh**
- 2.1.2. Two similar works each costing not less than ₹ **54.30 Lakh**
- 2.1.3. Three similar works each costing not less than ₹ **36.20 Lakh.**

In last 7 (Seven) Years ending previous day of Last date of submission of Bids.

- 2.2. The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to last date of submission of bids. This is applicable for 2.1 (This is not applicable for CPWD enlisted contractors of appropriate class in composite category). Similar work means **“Providing and Fixing of Auditorium / Multiplex chairs”**

To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under:-

I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for tendering in AIIMS in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. (Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid).

- 2.4 **When bids are invited from** Non CPWD/MES/PWD contractors, as per the provisions of clause 2.2, it will be mandatory for Non-CPWD contractors to upload the work experience certificate(s) and affidavit as per the provisions of clause 1.2.2. But for such bids, Class-I A and above registered contractors of composite category of CPWD/MES/PWD are eligible to submit the bids without submission of work experience certificate and affidavit. Therefore, CPWD/MES/PWD class-I A and above registered contractors of composite category of CPWD/MES/PWD shall upload

- two separate letters for experience certificate and affidavit that these documents are not required to be submitted by them. Uploading of these two letters is mandatory otherwise system will not clear mandatory fields.
3. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. CPWD 7 amended up to DG/CON/302 dated 09/02/2018 which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website www.cpwd.gov.in. Bidder shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form, which will form part of the agreement.
 4. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **03 (three) Months** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.
 5. **The site for the work is available.**

The architectural and structural drawings shall be made by successful bidder and got approved and vetted from IIT/NIT/Sates govt. institutes. (If applicable)
 6. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen from website [www.tenderwizard.com/AIIMS BHOPAL](http://www.tenderwizard.com/AIIMS_BHOPAL) or www.aiimsbhopal.edu.in and www.eprocure.gov.in free of cost.
 7. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last date and time of submission of bid as notified.
 8. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the quoted rates but before last date and time of submission of bid as notified.
 9. When bids are invited in three stage system and if it is desired to submit revised financial bid then it shall be mandatory to submit revised financial bid. If not submitted then the bid submitted earlier shall become invalid.
 10. Earnest Money in the form of Treasury Challan or Demand Draft or Pay Order or Banker`s Cheque or Deposit at Call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipt of a Scheduled Bank (drawn in favour of **Director, AIIMS Bhopal**) shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission.

The original EMD should be deposited in the office of Executive Engineer, inviting bids within the period of bid submission.

Copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the press notice shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. However, certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in press notice shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder only within a week physically in the office of tender opening authority.

Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose original EMD deposited with office of E.E.(E) AIIMS Bhopal and other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

The bid submitted shall be opened at **03.30 PM on 26/08/2019**

11. **The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee shall not be refunded if:**
- a) The bidder is found ineligible.
 - b) The bidder does not deposit original EMD Executive Engineer (E), AIIMS Bhopal.
 - c) The bidder does not upload all the documents (including GST registration) as stipulated in the bid document including the copy of receipt for deposition of original EMD.
 - d) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of bid opening authority.
 - e) If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above / below on the total amount of the tender or any section /sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
12. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% (Five Percent) of the bid amount within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of cash (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 10000/-) or Deposit at Call Receipt of any Scheduled Bank/Banker's Cheque of any Scheduled Bank/Demand Draft of any Scheduled Bank/Pay Order of any Scheduled Bank (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F' including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The Earnest Money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee. **The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses / registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund Code No. if applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the sub-contractors, if any, engaged by the contractor for the said work and Programme Chart (Time and Progress) within the period specified in Schedule F.**

13. The description of the work is as follows:-

“Providing and Fixing of Auditorium Chairs in Main Hall of Auditorium at AIIMS Bhopal.”

- Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidder shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.
14. The competent authority on behalf of the **Director, AIIMS Bhopal** does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
15. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
16. The competent authority on behalf of **Director, AIIMS Bhopal** reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidder shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
17. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the AIIMS Bhopal responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted as Account office or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any Gazetted Officer in the AIIMS Bhopal. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
18. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.

19. The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **Sixty (60) days** from the date of opening of **PQ bid** in case bids are invited on two envelop system (strike out as the case may be). If any bidder withdraws his bid before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the bid which are not acceptable to the department, **then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the bidder shall not be allowed to participate in the re-bidding process of the work.**
20. This Notice Inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder / contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of : -

Preamble

WHEREAS the Principal/Owner has floated the Tender No. **17/NIT/ABEU/AIIMS/BPL/2019-20**) (hereinafter referred to as "Tender/Bid") and intends to award, under laid down organizational procedure, contract for **"Providing and Fixing of Auditorium Chairs in Main Hall of Auditorium at AIIMS Bhopal."** here in after referred to as the "Contract".

AND WHEREAS the Principal / Owner values full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules, regulations, economic use of resources and of fairness/transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Contractor(s).

AND WHEREAS to meet the purpose aforesaid both the parties have agreed to enter into this Integrity Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Integrity Pact" or "Pact"), the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the Tender/Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Pact witnesses as under:

Article 1: Commitment of the Principal / Owner

- 1) The Principal/Owner commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:
 - (a) No employee of the Principal/Owner, personally or through any of his/her family members, will in connection with the Tender, or the execution of the Contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
 - (b) The Principal/Owner will, during the Tender process, treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal/Owner will, in particular, before and during the Tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential / additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the Tender process or the Contract execution.
 - (c) The Principal / Owner shall endeavour to exclude from the Tender process any person, whose conduct in the past has been of biased nature.
- 2) If the Principal/Owner obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the Indian Penal code (IPC) / Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (PC Act) or is in violation of the principles herein mentioned or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal / Owner will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can also initiate disciplinary actions as per its internal laid down policies and procedures.

Article 2: Commitment of the Bidder (s) / Contractor (s)

- 1) It is required that each Bidder / Contractor (including their respective officers, employees and agents) adhere to the highest ethical standards, and report to the Government / Department all suspected acts of **fraud or corruption or Coercion or Collusion** of which it has knowledge or becomes aware, during the tendering process and throughout the negotiation or award of a contract.
- 2) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) commit himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the Tender process and during the Contract execution:
 - a) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal / Owner's employees involved in the Tender process or execution of the Contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the Tender process or during the execution of the Contract.

The Bidder(s) / Contractor (s) will not enter with other Bidder (s) into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission

of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to cartelize in the bidding process.

- b) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act. Further the Bidder(s) / Contract(s) will not use improperly, (for the purpose of competition or personal gain), or pass on to others, any information or documents provided by the Principal/Owner as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
- c) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the names and addresses of agents / representatives in India, if any. Similarly Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall disclose names and addresses of foreign agents/representatives, if any. Either the Indian agent on behalf of the foreign principal or the foreign principal directly could bid in a tender but not both. Further, in cases where an agent participates in a tender on behalf of one manufacturer, he shall not be allowed to quote on behalf of another manufacturer along with the first manufacturer in a subsequent/parallel tender for the same item.
- d) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose (with each tender as per Performa enclosed) any and all payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the Contract
- 3) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.
- 4) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm indulge in fraudulent practice **means a willful misrepresentation or omission of facts or submission of fake / forged documents in order to induce public official to act in reliance thereof, with the purpose of obtaining unjust advantage by or causing damage to justified interest of others and/or to influence the procurement process to the detriment of the Government interests.**
- 5) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm use Coercive Practices (means the act of obtaining something, compelling an action or influencing a decision through intimidation, threat or the use of force directly or indirectly, where potential or actual injury may befall upon a person, his / her reputation or property to influence their participation in the tendering process).

Article 3: Consequences of Breach

Without prejudice to any rights that may be available to the Principal/Owner under law or the Contract or its established policies and laid down procedures, the Principal / Owner shall have the following rights in case of breach of this Integrity Pact by the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) and the Bidder / Contractor accepts and undertakes to respect and uphold the Principal / Owner's absolute right:

- 1) If the Bidder (s) / Contractor(s), either before award or during execution Contract has committed a transgression through a violation of Article 2 above or in any other form, such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal/Owner after giving 14 days notice to the contractor shall have powers to disqualify the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) from the Tender process or terminate / determine the Contract, if already executed or exclude the Bidder/Contractor from future contract award processes. The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of transgression and determined by the Principal/ Owner. **Such exclusion may be forever or for a limited period as decided by the Principal/Owner.**

- 2) **Forfeiture of EMD / Performance Guarantee / Security Deposit:**
 If the Principal/Owner has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the Tender process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated/determined the Contract or has accrued the right to terminate/determine the Contract according to Article 3(1), the Principal/Owner apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal/Owner, may in its considered opinion forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit, Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit of the Bidder / Contractor.

- 3) **Criminal Liability:** If the Principal/Owner obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder or Contractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder or Contractor which constitutes corruption within the meaning of Indian Penal code (IPC)/Prevention of Corruption Act, or if the Principal/Owner has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the same to law enforcing agencies for further investigation.

Article 4: Previous Transgression

- 1) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 5 years with any other Company in any country confirming to the anticorruption approach or with Central Government or State Government or any other Central/State Public Sector Enterprises in India that could justify his exclusion from the Tender process.

- 2) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the Tender process or action can be taken for banning of business dealings/ holding listing of the Bidder/Contractor as deemed fit by the Principal/ Owner.

- 3) If the Bidder/Contractor can prove that he has resorted / recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal/Owner may, at its own discretion, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

Article 5: Equal Treatment of all Bidders/Contractors/Subcontractors

- 1- The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all subcontractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. The Bidder / Contractor shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement/Pact by any of its Sub-contractors/sub-vendors.
- 2- The Principal / Owner will enter into Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
- 3- The Principal / Owner will disqualify Bidders, who do not submit, the duly signed Pact between the Principal/Owner and the bidder, along with the Tender or violate its provisions at any stage of the Tender process, from the Tender process.

Article 6- Duration of the Pact

This Pact begins when both the parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor / Vendor 03 Months after the completion of work under the contract or till the continuation of defect liability period, whichever is more and for all other bidders, till the Contract has been awarded.

If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pacts as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the Competent Authority of AIIMS Bhopal.

Article 7- Other Provisions

- 1) This Pact is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and jurisdiction is the **AIIMS** of the Principal / Owner, who has floated the Tender.
- 2) Changes and supplements need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- 3) If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this Pact must be signed by all the partners or by one or more partner holding power of attorney signed by all partners and consortium members. In case of a Company, the Pact must be signed by a representative duly authorized by board resolution.
- 4) Should one or several provisions of this Pact turn out to be invalid; the remainder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
- 5) It is agreed term and condition that any dispute or difference arising between the parties with regard to the terms of this Integrity Agreement / Pact, any action taken by the Owner/Principal in accordance with this **Integrity Agreement/ Pact or interpretation** there of shall not be subject to arbitration.

Article 8- LEGAL AND PRIOR RIGHTS

All rights and remedies of the parties hereto shall be in addition to all the other legal rights and remedies belonging to such parties under the Contract and/or law and the same shall be deemed to be cumulative and not alternative to such legal rights and remedies aforesaid. For the sake of brevity, both the Parties agree that this Integrity Pact will have precedence over the Tender / Contract documents with regard any of the provisions covered under this Integrity Pact.

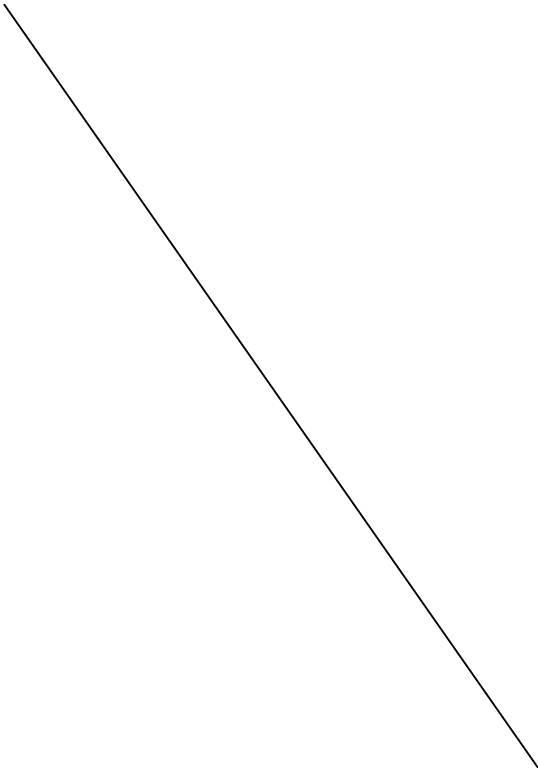

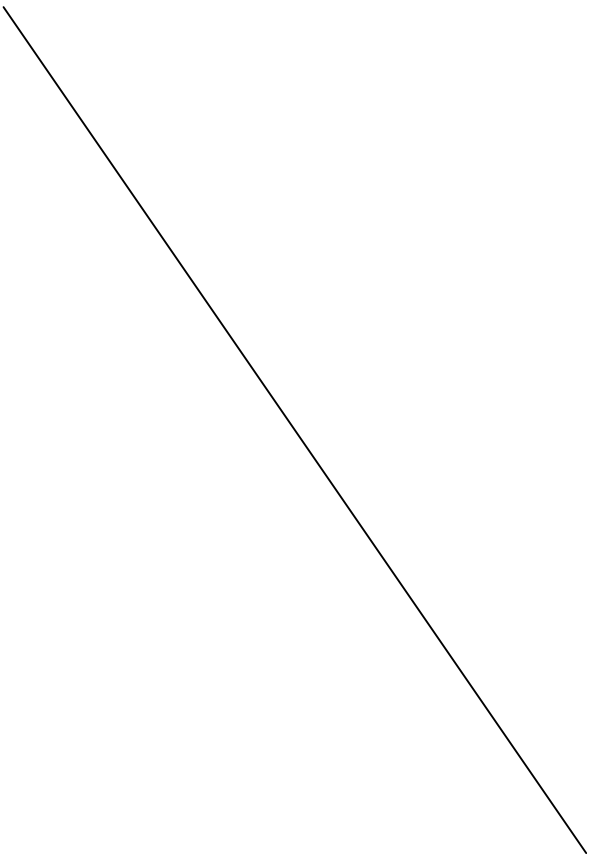

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GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The contractor (s) shall inspect the site of work before tendering and acquaint himself with the site conditions and no claim on this account shall be entertained by the department. The contractor (s) shall get him-self acquainted with nature and extent of the work and satisfy him-self about the availability of materials from kiln or approved quarries for collection and conveyance of materials required for construction.
2. The tenderer shall see the approaches to the site. In case any approach from main road is required by the contractor, the same shall be provided, improved and maintained by the contractor at his own cost. No payment shall be made on this account.
3. The contractor (s) shall give to the Municipality, Police and other authorities all necessary notices etc. that may be required by law and obtain all requisite Licenses for temporary obstructions, enclosures etc. and pay all fee, taxes and charges which may be leviable on account of these operations in executing the contract. He shall make good any damage to the adjoining property whether public or private and shall supply and maintain light and other illumination on for cautioning the public at night.
4. The contractor shall take all precautions to avoid accidents by exhibiting necessary caution boards day and night speed limit boards red flags, red lights and providing barriers. He shall be responsible for all dangers and incidents caused to existing / new work due to negligence on his part. No hindrances shall be caused to traffic during the execution of the work.

All Architectural drawings given in the tender other than those indicated in nomenclature of items are only indicative of the nature of the work and materials/fixings involved unless and otherwise specifically mentioned. - i. The contractor shall prepare an integrated programme chart for the execution of work, showing clearly all activities from the start of work to completion, with details of manpower, equipment and machinery required for the fulfillment of the programme within the stipulated period or earlier as indicated in the mile stones under clause 5 of the contract and submit the same for approval to the Engineer-in-Charge within ten days of the award of the contract.
- ii. The programmes chart should include the following:-
 - a. Descriptive note explaining sequence of various activities.

 - d. Programme of procurement of machinery/equipment's having adequate capacity commensurate with the quantum of work to be done within the stipulated period by the contractor.

If appears to the Engineer-in-Charge that the actual progress of work does not conform to the approved programme referred above the contractor shall produce a revised programme showing the modifications to the approved programme to ensure completion of the work within the stipulated time for completion.
12. The submission for approval by the Engineer-in-Charge of such programme or the furnishing of such particulars shall not relieve the contractor of any of his duties or responsibilities under the contract. This is without prejudice to the right of Engineer-in-Charge to take action against the contractor as per terms and conditions of the agreement.
13. If the work is carried out in more than one shift or during night no claim on this accounts shall be entertained.
14. Existing drains, pipes, cables, over-head wires, sewer lines, water lines and similar services encountered in the course of the execution of work shall be protected against the damage by the contractor at his own expense. The contractor shall not store materials or otherwise occupy any part of the site in a manner likely to hinder the operation of such services.
15. The contractor shall be responsible for the watch and ward/guard of the buildings, safety of all fittings and fixtures including sanitary and water supply fittings and fixtures provided by him against pilferage and breakage during the period of installations and thereafter till the building is physically handed over to the department. No extra payment shall be made on this account.
16. The contractor shall render all help and assistance in documenting the total sequence of this project by way of photography, slides, audio-video recording etc. Nothing extra shall be payable to the contractor on this account. However cost of photographs, slides, audio/videography etc shall be born by the department.
17. The contractor shall be fully responsible for the safe custody of materials brought by him issued to him even though the materials are under double lock key system.
18. No payment shall be made to the contractor for any damage caused by rain, snowfall, floods, earthquake or any other natural causes whatsoever during execution of work. The damages of the work will be made good by the contractor at his own cost and no claim on this account shall be entertained.
19. For construction works which are likely to generate malba/rubbish to the tune of more than a tempo/truck load, contractor shall dispose of malba, rubbish & other unserviceable materials and wastes at their own cost to the notified/specified dumping ground and under no circumstances these shall be stacked/dumped, even temporarily outside the construction premises.
20. The work shall be executed strictly as per sample approved.
21. All the materials shall be procured in lots of size as per approval of the engineer-in-charge. All procurements shall be handed over to the engineer-in-charge or his authorized representative. The materials required on day to day basis shall subsequently be issued by the representative of the engineer-in-charge to the agency.
22. The site shall be made available to the agency in consonance to the quantity of materials brought at site and handed over to the department. Any delay on this part shall be on account of the agency. In order to avoid any delay on this account, agencies are advised to bring big lots of materials so that there is no delay on this account.
23. Sample of all the materials of all lots shall be got tested independently by the engineer-in-charge at his discretion.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The work is to be executed with in the premises of ‘All India Institute of Medical Sciences Bhopal’. The contractor has to abide by the restriction imposed by the Institute authorities regarding working hours, labour movement and material movement etc. If contractor has to suspend the work due to such restriction imposed, nothing extra shall be payable on this account.
2. The contractor shall provide view cutter/barricades of appropriate type all around the work to segregate work site from general public. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account unless provision has been made in the agreement elsewhere.
3. The contractor shall execute the work in such away so that minimum possible dust pollution/Noise pollution is caused.
4. The contractor shall be allowed to load/unload the construction material only during the nonworking hours i.e. between 06:00 PM to 08:00 PM inside the academy premises.
5. The contractor has to strictly/follows the norms regarding labour safety and safe work practices.
6. The contractor has to provide following personal safety equipment’s to each worker employed on the work. The empty containers/ drums of full quantity of materials shall be kept intact by the agency till the maintenance period is over and release of security deposit, whichever is later.

1. TIP UP Auditorium Chairs-

Heavy Duty ergonomically designed chairs with gravity type, spring free TIP-up, rocking Auditorium Chairs fully upholstered with rigid PVC Back, conforming to the specifications. The Chair shall be fixed as per approved layout, which is to be submitted by the bidder based on actual dimensions of Auditorium steps measured at site and approved by the Engineer in Charge.
