Kinanthropometry is the area of science concerned with the measurement of human body composition. Kinanthropometry is the interface between anatomy and movement. It takes the measurement of the human body and determines its capability for function and movement in a range of settings. Accreditation scheme: ISAK has developed international standards for anthropometric assessment and an international anthropometry accreditation scheme (IAAS). A key element in it, is to teach precise Anthropometric measurements and to prevent technical errors of measurement (TEM).
