1. Foundation Course for the newly admitted MBBS & the B.Sc. (Nursing) batches begins at AIIMS, Bhopal

The Academic session for the newly admitted batches of MBBS Students and B.Sc. (Nursing) students has started at AIIMS, Bhopal. The Centre for Medical Education Technology (CMET) at AIIMS, Bhopal has organized a 4-week Foundation Course for these students with the purpose of orienting them to the new educational and professional environment, to equip them with some basic skills, and to sensitize them to their future roles.

The Foundation Course began on the 7th December with the Director of the Institute, Professor Sarman Singh addressing the students, on Professionalism and Ethics for health professionals. He warmly welcomed the students to the institution and congratulated them for their selection to an Institute of National Importance. He shared with them the culture and history of the noble professions of medicine and nursing. He expressed that while the students come to the institute from varied backgrounds and geographical regions, they must live in harmony and develop as a team besides growing and excelling individually. He urged the students to make the best of their training at the institute, and assured them that they will receive the best of education and support from the teachers at AIIMS, Bhopal. The session was conducted online and was attended by 110 MBBS Students and 62 B.Sc. Nursing students.

This was followed by address by the Dean (Academics) Professor Rajesh Malik who gave an overview of the undergraduate training to the students. He also informed them of the zero tolerance Anti-ragging policy at the institute, and the student support available. Next, the Dean (Research) Professor Debasis Biswas spoke to the students about research opportunities for undergraduate students, Ms. Mamta Verma (Principal of College of Nursing) spoke about the B.Sc. (Nursing) training at the institute, and Faculty from Examination Section, Professor R. Bharshankar apprised the students of the various assessments and examinations, and the marking scheme during the course.

The Foundation Course organized by the CMET Team under the able leadership of Professor Rehan Ul Haq, Chairman and Dr. Jyoti Nath Modi, Member Secretary, CMET. The

course will continue over the next 4 weeks and will include important sessions for students such as Biosafety, Role of healthcare workers in community, Stress management, Time management & Learning strategies, Communication skills, First aid, Basic Life Support, and Mentoring etc. The students will also be taken for hospital visits.
