**1. International nurses day celebration**

Every year 12<sup>th</sup> May is celebrated as **International Nurses Day** across the world. This day is dedicated to all the nursing professionals for their services and contribution to the society.

World Health Organization (WHO) has designated 2020 as The Year of the Nurse and Midwife. The theme for 2020 nursing day is, ***Nurses: A Voice to Lead – Nursing the World to Health***, clearly demonstrates that nursing services are vital in addressing a wide range of healthcare challenges including the present state of Covid-19 pandemic.

On the eve of the International Nursing Day, Professor Sarman Singh Director, AIIMS Bhopal congratulated and conveyed his best wishes to all nursing officers, faculty and student of college of nursing for preserving and selfless services towards the human health. Their services, sincerity and dedication have become most pertinent during the COVID-19 epidemic when everyone is looking towards the health professionals and nursing care remains the most crucial part of the health care system.

**2. Status report of Covid-19 patients at 08:00 AM (11<sup>th</sup> May)**

Total Twenty Eight (28) Covid-19 patients are presently admitted in AIIMS, Bhopal.

There is one (01) new admission of Covid-19 patient in AIIMS, Bhopal.

Twenty eight (28) Covid-19 positive patients are receiving treatment at Covid-19 wards, AIIMS, Bhopal. They are clinically stable.

There is no critically ill Covid-19 positive patient admitted in Covid-19 ICU at the time of releasing the press report.

All admitted patients are receiving treatment as per treatment protocol.

**Discharges Status:** No Covid-19 patient got discharge in last 24 hours from AIIMS Bhopal.

**Death Status:** Since beginning of Covid-19 crisis seven (08) patients have died in AIIMS Bhopal including one 61 year old female patient who breathed last in ICU on 10<sup>th</sup> May. The patient with diabetes and hypertension as co-morbidities was admitted to the COVID ICU of AIIMS, Bhopal on 28<sup>th</sup> April with fever and COVID pneumonia and on 09<sup>th</sup> May operated for Superior Mesenteric Artery Thrombosis (clotting of blood in a major blood vessel or an artery that supplies blood to the intestines and other vital organs).
